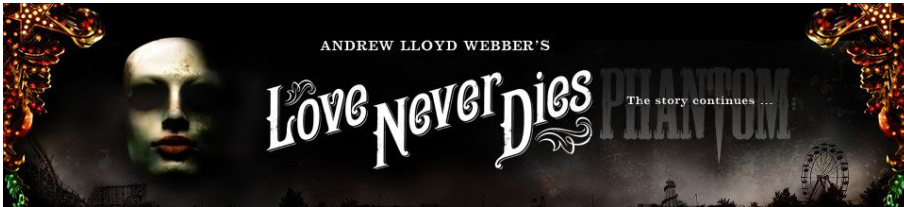
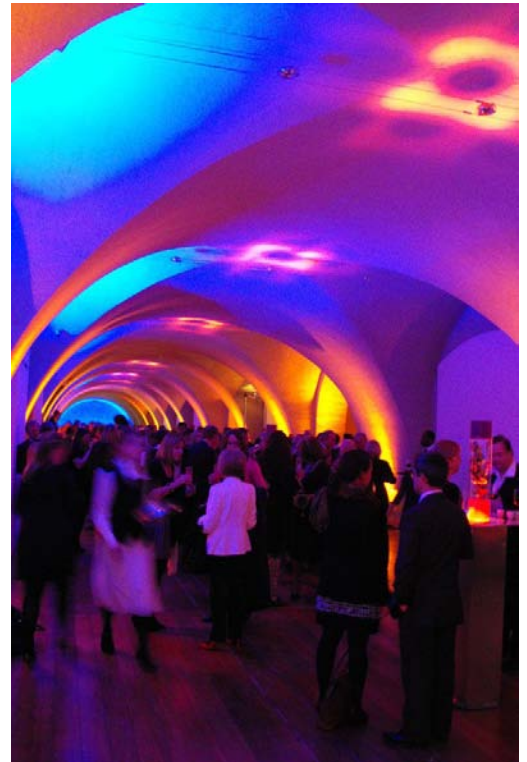


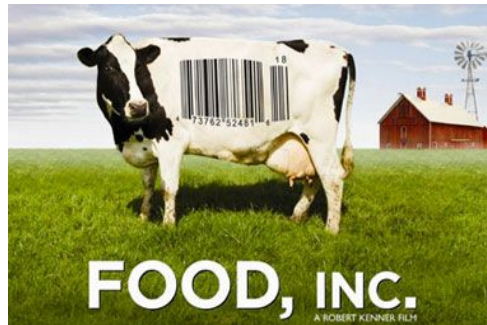
Great Ormond Street launches Love Never Dies at Somerset House
